1. Employment training - 4-step journey




Build the Skills

Building practical workplace skills in areas that interest participants.

Workshop examples:

- Communication skills
- Goal setting
- Presentation skills
- Working in a team
- Writing resumes & cover letters



Get the Qualifications

A range of formal courses and programs offered both in-house and by external training partners.

Training examples:

- Hospitality
- Computer & IT training
- Retail training



Secure Work Experience

Exposure to different roles and industries during multiple work experience placements each year in their industry of choice.



Find Employment

Once participants have completed their employment training they are ready to take the next step in their employment journey. Our disability employment program will support them to find and maintain their dream career.

2. Improved Social Skills

Build participant's confidence in social situations, experience new activities and make meaningful friendships and connections.

Program examples:

- Group social activities – museum visits, laser tag, bowling, movies, swimming
- Interest group activities – art, music, gaming, fitness, photography (facilitated in our offices)



3. Improved Independence Skills

Build participant's skills so they can live with greater independence.

- Budgeting and money handling
- Travel training
- Reading recipes, shopping & cooking



How we can support your school and students!

These options are **FREE** for the school and students.

School Groups (FREE)

Parent information sessions

- Omnia Inclusive information sessions - explore post-school pathways and employment options. Can be held in our offices or at your school.

Industry visits

- Meet different employers and visit worksites while learning about different industries.
*This is available for groups or individual students who are interested in that industry.

Workshops and Mini Programs

You can choose topics to suit your curriculum and students' needs.

In school workshops

- We can come to your class and deliver training on topics related to employment e.g. communication in the workplace, goal setting.

Workshops at Omnia Inclusive

- Retail training – using our in-house Mini Woolies Omnia training facility.
- Workshops of your choice related to employment, independence and social skills.

Travel Training Program

- Teaching students to plan and use public transport within the community.



Individual Students (FREE)

FREE sample day – try our activities

- Attend employment, social and/or independence days depending on goals and needs.

Mock Interviews

- Mock interviews and coaching for students thinking about entering the workforce.

Transition planning meetings

- Attend meetings to provide support and information on transition options and pathways after school.

Support accessing the NDIS

- Support to access and navigate the NDIS process for students and their families.

Parent support

- Meet with parents to discuss post-school pathways and individualised plans.



Teachers and Schools

(FREE)

Staff meeting presentations

- Provide information on Omnia Inclusive's NDIS services, our disability employment program and other post-school options.

Omnia Inclusive Mini Expos

- We host mini expos for schools to meet with providers and community services.

Support teachers with transition planning

- Advice and support with options for students looking to transition from school.



NDIS Funded Options

For any students currently in Year 10, 11 or 12

Individual students

School holiday programs

- We offer school holiday activities across our employment, independence and social programs.

Job coaching 1:1

- Individual support to develop resumes and cover letters, explore different industries, and develop skills for work.

Work experience

- We work closely with the schools to set up work experience placements with our existing employer partners.
- We can also provide one-on-one support during the work experience placement to ensure success.

Transition from school supports

- Start accessing our program 1 day per week in the last year of school (with school approval and as part of transition from school).
